## ATC participates in MoodleMoot 2018

<u>Athens Technology Center (ATC)</u> supports the <u>GFOSS – Open Technologies Alliance</u> and participates in the <u>2nd Pan-Hellenic MoodleMoot Conference</u>, held on 29 & 30 November at the National Technical University of Athens (NTUA).
